City to Launch New Web Site

City Commission unveils new web site at July 22nd meeting



We are very excited to announce the launch of our new website in July. The new online experience, based on analysis of online traffic and people's viewing behavior, features more tools and information not just for city residents, but those visiting the area as well.

Along with an updated look and enhanced user functionality, all of the content on the site has been updated and improved. The site will offer a sharable events calendar, local photography by Joshua Nowicki, and all the latest city news and construction updates on local projects.

To add to the user experience, the site has been created to dynamically change shape to fit whatever device you're on. For example, you'll be able to comfortably browse the site on your iPhone or tablet, as well as, a desktop computer.

We've also added the ability for you to more easily contact us to share your thoughts, report something that needs attention, or upload your own photography to share with others (the site receives well over 115,000 visitors every year!).

For added functionality, we've enhanced the search controls, giving you more ways to find content on our site. And we've created a "smart" main menu that analyzes our pages in real-time and orders them for you based on how popular they are. You can learn everything from how to obtain a building permit to registering to vote with our new "How Do I?" section.
