Construction at Niles and Napier Week of May 4th

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CONSTRUCTION WORK AT INTERSECTION OF NAPIER AND NILES TO START MONDAY, MAY 4

(ST. JOSEPH, Mich.) DZI Construction Services Inc., contractor for the CVS project located on Niles Avenue, informed the City of St. Joseph that construction, located at the intersection of Napier and Niles avenues (M63), is scheduled to start Monday, May 4th. The purpose of the work, which has been reviewed and approved by the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) and City of St. Joseph, is to install a fire suppression line to service the development. While the work is underway, the City will replace a leaking water valve and add an additional water valve in order to improve system reliability and level of service to the surrounding neighborhoods.

Construction will be undertaken near the middle of the intersection and includes a lane closure for southbound Niles Avenue traffic, a detour for left-turn motorists from Niles Avenue onto Napier Avenue, and restricting left turns to a single lane for westbound Napier Avenue traffic. The approved traffic control plan is attached. Motorists should expect delays and may desire to seek alternate routes while the construction is underway. CVS's contractor estimates the work to be complete and traffic restored to normal on Monday, May 11th.
