Area 4th & 5th grade students are invited to sign up for CAMP 911. This will be held at Riverview Park in St. Joseph on June 11th and 12th from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

CAMP 911 is co-sponsored by the St. Joseph Public Safety Department, the St. Joseph Township Police Department, Medic 1, United States Coast Guard, and the Berrien County Marine Division.

CAMP 911 is a fun, interactive, hands-on introduction to public safety services. The program will teach area youth how to prevent common traffic and home injuries, how to give simple but life saving emergency care and will provide information about working in public safety careers.

Participants will get hands on experience in areas of law enforcement, fire services, emergency medical service and water rescue. Participants will also get an opportunity to interact closely with Public Safety Officers, EMT's and members of the Marine Division.

The cost for CAMP 911 is \$25.00 and this includes lunch for both days and a t-shirt. CAMP 911 is open to the first forty 4th & 5th grade boys and girls who sign up.
