Blossomtime Festival



The Grand Floral Parade is the crown iewel of the Blossomtime Festival and is celebrating its 118th year in 2024. The Grand Floral Parade begins in St. Joseph and continues through the city, across the Bicentennial Bridge and into Benton Harbor. St. Joseph and Benton Harbor have been the host cities since the Parade's inception in 1923.

This year's schedule includes the Youth Parade on Saturday May 4th, at noon starting at Bear Park on State St. and Market St. and ending at State Street and Ship Street; the Run for the Buds 5k & 10k on May 11 at 10:30AM - beginning at 715 Ship St.; and the Grand Floral Parade on Saturday May 11 at 1PM - beginning at Main St. and Pearl St.

Parking and Storage of Boats, Trailers & RVs

In March 2024, the City Commission updated the Zoning Ordinance associated with parking or storage of boats, trailers, off-road vehicles, recreational vehicles (campers) and other similar equipment, confirming and streamlining the language. The regulations are as follows:

- 1. Parking or storage of equipment in the front yard must be on a hard surface and is limited to 48 hours
- 2. Equipment can be parked or stored in the rear yard if located five feet from the side or rear lot line and on a hard surface.
- 3. Equipment cannot be occupied or connected to electric, sewer, water or gas service.

Time for a New Air Conditioner Unit or Generator?

Replacing or installing a new air conditioner, generator or similar equipment? A mechanical permit is required before any work begins. Check with your contractor before they start work and display the permit in your window.

Remember:

- Equipment should be installed per the manufacturer's recommendations while complying with the requirements of the City's Zoning Ordinance (Section 3.9.3.C).
- Equipment must be located in the rear or side yard, a minimum of three feet from the lot line.
- There are screening requirements for commercial properties and properties with more than three dwelling units.
- Once work is complete, your contractor must call for a final inspection.

Construction and Preventive Maintenance Update

Lead Service Line Replacements are continuing throughout 2024 with upcoming work on Kingsley Ave. between South State St. and Niles Ave., South State St. between Wallace Ave. and DuVerne Ave., Morton Ave. from Harrison Ave. to Wisconsin Ave., Michigan Ave. from Morton Ave. to the easterly dead end, and Morrison Ave. from Wayne St. to the dead end.

The Upton Drive Reconstruction Project, which includes full reconstruction of Upton Drive from the southerly limits near the St. Joseph River to Momany Drive, is underway and expected to continue through the fall.

The Lake Boulevard and Broad Street Resurfacing Project, the limits being Hatch St. to Ship St. on Lake Boulevard, and from State St. to Lake Boulevard on Broad St., is expected to begin April 4, ending in mid-June.

Sewer Cleaning & Televising is underway with a completion expected in mid-May.

The 2024 Sidewalk Replacement Project is underway, predominantly in the northwest quadrant of the City (north of Central Avenue and west of Main Street/M63).

The 2023 Asphalt Preventative Maintenance Project will be completed in spring/early summer 2024. Due to weather conditions, some of the roads selected for fog sealing, also known as seal coating, were not treated last fall. A map of the streets selected for this preventive maintenance measure is available on the City Engineer webpage.


