- Light fireworks one at a time, then move back quickly
- Never try to relight or pick up fireworks that haven't ignited fully
- Never use fireworks while impaired by alcohol or drugs

Brush Collection

Brush collection will take place from June 3 to 7 and July 8 to 12. Place brush pile in the street gutter, no earlier than the day before collection begins.

Tree limbs and brush must be less than six inches in diameter and no longer than eight feet in length. Stack brush so the larger ends face the same direction.

Remember that brush collection is just for brush. Please do not include leaves, ornamental grasses, grass clippings, flowers, weeds, sod or garden vegetation.

Construction Update

Lead Service Line Replacements are continuing throughout 2024 with upcoming work on South State St. between Wallace Ave. and Winchester Avenue

The Upton Drive Reconstruction Project, which includes full reconstruction of Upton Drive from the southerly limits near the St. Joseph River to Momany Drive, is underway and expected to continue through the fall.

The 2024 Sidewalk Replacement Project is underway, predominantly in the northwest quadrant of the City (north of Central Avenue and west of Main Street/M63).

The 2023 Asphalt Preventative Maintenance Project will be completed in spring/early summer 2024. Due to weather conditions, some of the roads selected for fog sealing, also known as seal coating, were not treated last fall. A map of the streets selected for this preventive maintenance measure is available on the City Engineer webpage.

Temporary Sign Regulations

Remember that temporary signs have restrictions. A temporary sign is any sign posted or displayed for a limited amount of time, such as banners, construction signs, garage sale signs and political signs.

One and two-family dwellings are allowed to display not more than 24 square feet of signage at any one time, with the maximum size of each sign not to exceed six square feet. The maximum height of temporary signage is four feet and all signs must be located on private property.
